

# **Living with HIV in Direct Provision**

#### **Overview**

This one-day course introduces key aspects of working with people who are living with HIV in Direct Provision. The course was developed over a period of a year whilst working with a group of people living in Direct Provision accommodation and aims to share the experiences and learning gained from this process.
